

### **Directors** Notes

Peanuts, the comic strip by Charles M. Schulz, ran from 1950 to 2000 with 17,897 strips in all. I remember reading the comics for two decades at least and watching the movies over and over again. My favorite was *A Charlie Brown Christmas* which aired in 1965. At 8 years old I could relate to Charlie Brown who always got picked on yet kept being positive about the world. He was a lovable idealist and was aware of his failures. We all knew the bossy Lucy van Pelts in the world and every character represented someone in my playground.

When we first started rehearsing in October I was surprised to hear that none of the cast had seen *A Charlie Brown Christmas.* They eventually watched it and we all went to the Peanuts movie together. I know they all fell in love with the characters.

When I picked the show as part of the Northumberland Players season, I was concerned because the show was about the spiritual side of Christmas. It's about how Christmas has lost its meaning. Would the multicultured schools attend? Would a story about a Christian celebration resonate? The show has sold out.

I taught in the public school system when we were told we had to stop saying the Lord's prayer, reading bible stories, and making any reference to religion. I understood why there was a problem in a multicultured province, but with this legislation, the public schools threw out the spiritual aspect of life and with it, perhaps, the respect for the wonderful diversity of faith. This show is more than a kids' show for me. It is about the power of faith that can translate into any religion. It says to us all to understand the true meaning of any celebration. Christmas, Ramadan, Diwali, Vaisaki, Yom Kippur and all other holy days remind me of the richness of human culture and faith.

I hope these kids can tell this story and do justice to Charles Schultz's vision.
